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INTRODUCTION

When the will of God is taught and understood, the faith required to receive and experience it is released.

“So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God” - Romans 10:17

One area many believers are not walking in victory like God expects is in the area of finances. This is partly because many preachers shy away from preaching it because they are afraid of being associated with the so-called ‘Prosperity Preachers’. The truth is that Satan is behind the attack on the message of Kingdom Prosperity. Because this message is not preached as it is supposed to be preached, believers are not equipped to walk in it. Another reason why this message is not preached is that Satan has deceived preachers, making

them believe that before they can be qualified to preach about the will of God for His children to prosper and increase, they must first be rich. He makes them think that people will not receive their message because they are not yet 'rich'. That is a lie, my brothers and sisters. Apostle Paul was not a 'rich man' by today's standard of being rich, but his personal needs and the needs of his ministry were met, and he even had extra. He once said,

"I now have all I need – more than enough – I'm abundantly satisfied! For I've received the gift you sent by Epaphroditus and viewed it as a sweet sacrifice, perfumed with the fragrance of your faithfulness, which so pleasing to God!" - Philippians 4:18 (TPT).

He preached this message faithfully in season and out of season. He continued preaching this message even when people thought he was a poor man. He refused to let other people's perceptions of him stop him. His contradictory situations did not limit the impact of his message and ministry.

“As sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as POOR, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.” – 2 Corinthians 6:10

The next time Satan tries to discourage you from preaching the word of prosperity, tell him “Even though people think I am poor now, I have the power to make wealth, both for myself and for others. So shut up Satan and get out of here in Jesus' name.”

What many people do not know is that their faith is the first to come alive when they preach. Faith comes by hearing the word of God, even if you are the one preaching it. As you continue to preach it, God will see to it that you experience what you preach, so that people will believe your message when they see God bringing His word to pass in your life.

I was reading Chapter Nine of Apostle Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians in the evening of March 14, 2021, when God began to speak to me about believing Him to have more than enough. I was reading

it in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition. When I got to verse eight, I stopped and began to meditate on it.

“And God is able to make all grace (every favour and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].”

I began to ask God to tell me why I have not been having more than enough in my finances. He instructed me to continue reading and I would find the answer. I discovered that I have been faithful in giving my tithes and offerings, but I have not been faithful in my giving to the poor and the needy. I discovered that giving to the poor was the missing key. He then began to teach me how to give and what happens when I give to the poor and mandated me to share what He revealed to me

with the rest of the members of His body. This is why this book was written.

I believe God led you to get this book because He wants to usher you into a season of financial overflow when you will always have more than you need. I pray for grace to be a doer of the word in Jesus' name.



OVERFLOW IS THE WILL OF GOD

You can only touch many people's lives and be part of advancing the Kingdom of God with your finances when you have more than you need to pay your bills. If what you have is not even enough to pay all your bills, how would you be able to help other people out? My friend, God is able, God is willing, and God is ready to give you more than you need, so that you will always have the resources to meet the needs of mankind, across the earth. Please receive this. Just say "Lord I believe and receive this word", and do not worry

about how He is going to make it happen. There is nothing too hard for Him to do. There is no height He cannot take you to. If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes (Mark 9:23).

“Yes, God is more than ready to overwhelm you with every form of grace, so that you will have more than enough of everything – every moment and in every way. He will make you overflow with abundance in every good thing you do.” – 2 Corinthians 9:8 (TPT)

Jesus Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law (which amounts to spiritual death, sickness, and poverty), and gave us access to the blessing of Abraham.

“Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having a become curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.” – Galatians 3:13-14

For us to appreciate this, we need to understand what blessing God gave Abraham. Let us go to the book of Genesis 12:1-3

“Now the Lord had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, from your family and from your father’s house, to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

God fulfilled these covenant promises in the life of Abraham.

“Now Abraham was old, well advanced in age; and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things...The Lord has blessed my master greatly, and he has become great; and He has given him flocks and herds, silver and gold,

male and female servants, and camels and donkeys.” -

Genesis 24:1, 35

Do not let anyone deceive you, the blessing of God is not just spiritual; when you are blessed, it manifests in the[natural]. You have material things to show that you are a blessed person. Abraham was blessed, and because of that blessing, he enjoyed a good long life and had a very prosperous business with many employees.

All these blessings God promised Abraham are also yours as one who has been redeemed. They are part of the inheritance you are born into as a child of God. God has already blessed you with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ (Ephesians 1:3). You only need to know what He has made available to you and find out what to do to access them. God already has a plan to make you as great as a nation. There are already such individuals on the earth today, who are stronger than nations, so do not think God was just playing with

words. He wants to make your name famous and distinguished. He has already done everything necessary for you to be a blessing, dispensing good to others. You have been blessed to be a blessing to all the families of the earth. This is the primary purpose of the blessing. You are not blessed for yourself and your family alone. You need to get the big picture. You need to receive this vision of heaven. You are bigger than what you see. Inside you is the potential to be a global breadwinner. I am convinced that someone reading this book will catch this vision. You will be so blessed that many other people will also become wealthy because of their association with you. This is the will of God for you and I. Abraham received this blessing by faith and so must we (Romans 4:17-21).

For you to fulfil your destiny of being a blessing to all the families of the earth you must have more than you need for yourself and your family. This is why God is speaking to you through this book, to prepare you for a higher dimension of increase. I recommend you get my

THE MISSING KEY

So much has been taught about giving our tithes and offerings, and about the blessings of giving towards the preaching of the Gospel. Believers around the world, including myself have developed our faith in the principle of ‘Sowing and Reaping’, and have testimonies from engaging it. But God revealed to me that not a lot has been taught about giving to the poor and the needy, and this is why we have not been having an overflow in our finances to be able to give to others like we are called to do. I will be sharing with you what God has revealed to me in this regard.

The Apostle Paul spent a good amount of time and energy encouraging believers to give generously to support the poor believers living in Jerusalem. In his second letter to the Corinthians, he made one more appeal to the church at Corinth, stirring up their faith and passion to give to the poor and the needy. We shall be studying chapter nine of this letter to uncover a missing key to having more than we need financially.

On the 14th of March, 2021 I was reading this chapter in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition. Verse eight got my attention;

"And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]." - 2 Corinthians 9:8

I began to ask God, "Why am I not having more than

enough in my finances?" He told me to read on to find the answer to my question. I discovered that for me to step into the realm of having more than enough, I have to be consistent, intentional and organized in giving to the poor as much as I am in giving God my tithes and offerings. I understood that the purpose of having an overflow in my finances is to be able to bless other people in need with the extra, and if I do it faithfully, I will keep having an overflow for the rest of my life. God will keep multiplying my seeds and I will keep having an abundant harvest.

"As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."

Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God." - 2 Corinthians 9:9-11

God has a system for the sustenance of all His creations. He made provision for the plants to stay alive and multiply. He supplies food for the birds of the air, the sea creatures and every animal on the earth.

“Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they...So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.”

Matthew 6:26, 28-29

Man is the crown of God’s creation. If He cares so much about plants and animals, He cares much more about man and has a system in place to keep them alive so they can be fruitful and multiply. He uses men to meet the fundamental needs of other men. Every human

being needs food, water, shelter and clothing to stay alive and God never fails to supply them. Even the poorest people on earth have something to eat, drink, wear, and a place to stay. The quality of these provisions varies, but the important thing is that they have them.

The poor and the needy have a very special place in the heart of God, and He never forsakes them. And anyone who takes care of them (whether born again or not) touches His heart. Have you noticed that some of the wealthiest people on earth are not even Christians? One thing they all have in common is that they are all involved in one form of charitable endeavors or more. They spend a huge part of their wealth helping other people. This is not a coincidence. Whatever you are doing for the poor you are doing for Jesus Christ.

**“Then the King will say to those on His right hand,
‘Come you blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom
prepared for you from the foundation of the world:
for I was hungry and you gave me food; I was thirsty**

and you gave me drink; I was a stranger and you took me in; I was naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to me.’ Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and take you in, or naked and clothed you? Or when did we see you sick, or in prison, and come to you?’ And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me.’ -

Matthew 25:34-40

Jesus Christ is personally touched by every sincere act of generosity, and He sees to it that the giver is adequately rewarded. Have you ever heard the cliché “Givers never lack”? It is very true. Genuine generous giver lacks. They are God’s partners, and He ensures that they stay alive and prosperous so they can keep giving to the poor. No matter how much we confess

“wealth transfer” God will never take money from a man who is actively taking care of the poor and give it to a born-again person who only prays for God to meet the needs of the poor. What you do not know is that whenever you pray that God would provide for a community that has been hit by a natural disaster, for example, He speaks to one of His partners to go meet their needs. People who are committed to meeting the needs of the poor never become poor. The generations after them enjoy the blessing of God. This explains why ‘the rich keep getting richer’ and ‘the poor keep getting poorer’. The rich take advantage of every opportunity to give while the poor take advantage of every opportunity to grab and keep. What you receive does not make you financially well-off; it is what you give that does.

God is calling you to come up higher and partner with Him to take care of the poor. This call is absolutely for your good. The poor will be taken care of without you. Join the few partners in God’s welfare program for the poor. This is what you have been missing. Let me

show you some things you have been missing.

“Blessed is he who considers the poor; The Lord will deliver him in time of trouble. The Lord will preserve him and keep him alive, and he will be blessed on the earth; You will not deliver him to the will of his enemies. The Lord will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed”. - Psalm

41:1-3

Giving to the poor gives you unhindered access to the blessing of God that makes rich and forbids sorrow. God will personally see to it that you are delivered from every trouble. He will deliver you from every plan of the enemy to steal, kill and destroy your life and all that belongs to you. You will always have the victory in every battle of life. God will make sure that you are always in good health. He will take care of whatever is threatening your life. You will have a long and prosperous life. There is no earthly insurance policy that guarantees these benefits. Giving to the poor is the greatest ‘Life Insurance ‘on earth. If you are a giver to

the poor, you have the right to claim all the above benefits whenever you need them.

“Every time you give to the poor you make a loan to the Lord. Don’t worry – you will be repaid in full for all the good you’ve done.” Proverbs 19:17 (TPT)

Nothing you give to the poor is wasted; it will come back to you. Just Imagine giving God a loan. When He pays you back, it comes with good interest. Whenever you borrow from someone, you enter a covenant with that person. So, whenever you give to the poor, you enter a covenant with the Almighty God. Tell me how you can fail when you are in partnership with God.

“He who has a generous eye will be blessed, for he gives of his bread to the poor.” Proverbs 22:9

Again, we see that God releases a special blessing to the generous. The Good News Bible puts it in a very

simple way:

“Be generous and share your food with the poor. You will be blessed for it.” - Proverbs 22:9

You do not have to be a billionaire to do this. You get a blessing by just sharing your food with the poor. The blessing is supernatural empowerment to prosper. This is simple enough. In the next chapter, I will be teaching you how to give to get the maximum result.

“He who gives to the poor will not lack, but he who hides his eyes will have many curses.” - Proverbs 28:27

The word of God is true my brother and my sister. There are no casual statements in the scriptures. God says exactly what He means and if we believe what He says, we shall receive what He promised. He says, “He who gives to the poor will not lack!” If we believe He means what He said, then we must show it by our actions, otherwise, you have what the Bible calls 'a dead

faith' in James 2:26. If you believe that anyone who gives to the poor shall not lack, then you should start giving to the poor if you do not want to lack. God will terminate every form of lack and want in your life in Jesus' name. I pray for you, that God will release the zeal to put the words you are hearing to pass in Jesus' name.

Add giving to the poor to giving to God and every other form of giving you have been involved in and by some supernatural means, you will start having extra, and the extra will continue to increase until you are giving away more than you need for yourself and your family. This is one of the missing links. You do not have to become wealthy to start doing this; as a matter of fact, you have to start doing this to become wealthy.

Start with the little you have now. In the last chapter, I will show you practical ways to start giving to the poor with whatever amount of money you have in your current financial position.



HOW TO GIVE

Not every giving is rewarded. There is a right way to give to receive a reward from God. Jesus taught about this in Matthew chapter 6 and the Apostle Paul also shed more light on it in 2 Corinthians 9. We shall be looking at both to learn how to get God's desired returns on our giving. I believe that with what the Holy Spirit will teach you in this chapter you will receive an abundant harvest whenever you give from henceforth in Jesus' name.

“Take heed that you do not do your charitable deeds

before men, to be seen by them. Otherwise, you have no reward from your Father in heaven. Therefore, when you do a charitable deed, do not sound a trumpet before you as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory from men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. But when you do a charitable deed, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, that your charitable deed may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will Himself reward you openly.” - Matthew 6:1-4

1. GIVE WITH A PURE MOTIVE

Your motive for giving is sometimes more important than what you are giving. If your motive is wrong, you might as well keep your gift to yourself because you may not be rewarded by God. Your only reward might be a few likes on social media. Do not give to show off or to be admired by other people. Let your giving be love-motivated. Give because you genuinely

care about the well-being of the one you are giving to. Give because you want to be a blessing. Do not even give because you want to get a blessing from God. Whenever your giving is motivated by genuine love for God and for other people you will certainly receive the blessing of God.

2. GIVE HONOURABLY

Jesus commanded us not to draw attention to ourselves when we give, otherwise, the praise of men would be our only reward. When you give, please protect the dignity of the one to whom you are giving, particularly when you are giving to people who are in need. Do not go with video cameras to record the distribution of your gifts, and please do not post it on any social media platform. Please honour God with this and honour the person you are giving to. Remember that whatever you do to or for the poor touches Jesus, especially if they are believers. Please respect the people

and give to them honourably. Do not give people stale or expired food. Do not hurt people's self-esteem.

If you are a charity organization and are obligated to record your charity activities on camera to report to your partners or sponsors, please still do it honourably. Just be guided by the love of God. May God give you understanding in Jesus' name.

3. GIVE CHEERFULLY AND WILLINGLY

"Let giving flow from your heart, not from a sense of religious duty. Let it spring up freely from the joy of giving – all because God loves hilarious generosity" .

2 Corinthians 9:7

Never give because a 'man of God' coerced you to give. The only reward you will get from that giving would be having the 'man of God' off your back. You will get zero rewards from God. Do not give because you do not want people to think you are stingy.

Do not give out of compulsion. Only give when

you have made up your mind to give, not when someone else is pressuring you to give. Even when it is offering time in church, do not give if you won't be doing it from the heart. With all you have learnt about the blessing that accompanies giving, you should be excited whenever you have an opportunity to give, knowing that you are not throwing your money into the fire. You are giving to God not man and He never fails to reward people who give to Him.

If your giving is not from a willing heart, it will not be rewarded.

“...This is the thing which the Lord commanded, saying: ‘Take from among you an offering to the Lord. Whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it as an offering to the lord...” - Exodus 35:4-5

You must learn to put the flesh under when it comes to giving. This is because the flesh does not like to give, it only wants to receive. It takes always yielding to the Holy Spirit to be a giver. Sometimes the most

convenient to do is to 'get all you can, can all you get and sit on the can' – to keep your money to yourself and your family. But your born-again spirit who is one with the Holy Spirit always wants to give; his character is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, and self-control. He always wants to give but the flesh (the un-yielded body and unrenewed mind) does not want to give. You must learn how to tell the flesh to shut up and put on a smile as you give. Willingness to give flows from a redeemed spirit that is yielded to the leadings of the Holy Spirit. Whenever the Holy Spirit prompts you to give, tell your flesh, "Cheer up boy, let's do this. At the end of the day God will give us more than we are about to give right now!"

Do not give with a frown on your face. Give cheerfully and willingly and you will be richly rewarded.

4. GIVE GENEROUSLY

You determine how much you receive from how much you give. It is the quality and quantity of your seeds that determines the quality and quantity of your harvest.

“But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.”

2 Corinthians 9:6

The Good News Bible puts it like this, **“...the person who sows few seeds will have a small crops; the one who sows many seeds will have many large crop.”** The Passion Translation puts it so nicely, **“...A stingy sower will reap a meagre harvest, but the one who sows from a generous spirit will reap an abundant harvest.”**

I like to make a very important point here. The quality and quantity of the seed is determined by how

much God has given to the sower. One sower gives a gift worth 20 US Dollars, and it moves God because compared to his financial capacity at that time that is a lot of seed. At the same time, another person would give 5000 US Dollars and compared to how much God has blessed him financially, that would not be a generous giving. In Luke 21, a poor woman cast two mites and Jesus said she gave more than everyone else.

The point God is trying to bring across to you is to give your best, according to your level per time. Do not wait until you have billions of dollars to start giving. If you want to give scholarships to many in the future, begin by buying lunch for a kid today. Give your best per time and see God release the best of the harvest to you. Grab every opportunity you get to be a blessing to someone. Give until you feel it. Give sacrificially. Go out of your way to put a smile on somebody's face. Include giving to the poor in your monthly budget. The same way a part of all your income goes to God, let a part of all your income go to the poor. That is one thing that will

cause you to always have more than you need. Remember the poor person does not need money as much as you need the blessing you will receive when you give.

I challenge you start to a trust fund with your wife, to help some less privileged children complete their education. Let your business or church start a feeding program for the poor. You don't have to give two slices of bread to a thousand people; you can properly feed twenty people and you would have done more than the guy who gives two slices of bread to one thousand people and posts the pictures on Facebook with the hashtag #feedingTheMultitude. If your church runs a charity program, give into it every month. Look for ways to be a blessing to the needy every week. As you keep at it, you will be expanding your capacity to receive from God.

5. GIVE CONSISTENTLY

One of the reasons people do not receive their harvest is because of their inconsistency in giving.

“In the morning sow your seed, and in the evening do not withhold your hand; for you do not know which will prosper, either this or that, or whether both alike will be good” Ecclesiastes 11:6

Do not stop giving. Whenever there is an opportunity to give, God is about to move you into a new dimension of increase. Remember you will always have something to give, you only need to look inwards. You can give a plate of food to some homeless person around the corner and that would be the trigger that launches you into your wealthy place. Anything receivable is ‘give-able’. Do not stop giving when times are hard, that is when to give so that you can come out of the tight corner.

“And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.” - Galatians 6:9-10

The day you plant a seed is not the day you harvest it. You have to keep watering the seed and clearing off the weeds for a season until it is harvesting time. If you get discouraged and stop watering the seeds, you will lose your harvest. You should never get tired of giving. Keep doing good. Do not get discouraged and quit. Inconsistency is an enemy of harvest. One day your harvest will come. Only God knows your due season. He alone knows the time He has appointed for your harvest. Your harvest is in phases and seasons. As you remain consistent in giving, you will have a harvest all year round. Sometimes the harvest will be big, at other times it will be small. Do not stop giving and you will not stop receiving. There is no graduation or retirement in giving, you only change levels.

I pray that God will keep blessing you as you remain consistent in giving towards the expansion of His Kingdom and also to the poor as He gives you opportunities, in Jesus' name. Amen.



WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU GIVE?

Something happens in the realm of the spirit each time you give to the poor. Some spiritual forces are set in motion whenever you give. God responds positively each time you give. Immediately your seed touches the ground, the process leading to your harvest begins. In this chapter, we shall learn about some things to expect as a result of our giving to the poor. I pray for a good understanding for you in Jesus' name.

1. GOD IS PLEASED

Whenever you give cheerfully to the needy, you make God happy. This is a big deal; you get the attention of The King of kings and the Creator of the heavens and the earth by one act of generosity? Yes, you do.

“Let each one [give] as he has made up his own mind and purposed in his heart, not reluctantly or sorrowfully or under compulsion, for GOD LOVES (He takes pleasure in, prizes above other things, and is unwilling to abandon or to do without) a cheerful (joyous, “prompt to do it”) giver [whose heart is in his giving]”. 2 Corinthians 9:7 (AMPC)

God loves a cheerful giver. God takes pleasure in a cheerful giver. God prizes a cheerful giver above all other things. God is unwilling to abandon a Cheerful giver. God is unwilling to do without a cheerful giver. This is so amazing. You get God in your

affairs by giving to the needy, and if God is for you who can be against you? Do you know that God really appreciates you partnering with Him to take care of His children? It is therefore a wise decision to keep doing what gets God's attention every day.

2. YOU WILL ALWAYS HAVE MORE THAN YOU NEED

When you become consistent in giving to the poor, God begins to give you increases in your finances. Eventually, you will begin to notice that for some supernatural reason, you do not run out of money anymore. At the end of the month, you will still have some money left, unlike before where money ran out before the next payday. If you continue, you will begin to have additional streams of income. And if you do not stop giving to the poor, one day you will notice that what you give is far more than what you use to pay your bills and meet your needs.

“God is able to give you more than you need, so that you will ALWAYS have all you need for yourselves and MORE THAN ENOUGH for every good cause.”

2 Corinthians 9:8 (GNB)

We cannot explain how God will bring this increase; that is why it is supernatural. This is a prophetic book coming from a ministry whose mandate is to equip believers for the ‘Dominion Era’ of the church in the last days. I speak to you by the inspiration of the Holy Ghost that if you will be consistent in this three-dimensional giving: Giving your complete tithes, Giving towards the work of the ministry of the word (to anointed ministries committed to winning the lost and discipleship), and Giving to the poor and the needy according to your capacity for the next three months, you will have the kind of breakthroughs that will amaze you. Receive grace to do this in Jesus' name. Amen.

3. YOUR GIVING WILL NEVER BE FORGOTTEN

Whenever you give to the poor, it is registered in eternity, and it will never be forgotten. Your good deeds will never be forgotten.

"As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor; his deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever!" - 2 Corinthians 9:9

Generations after you shall eat of the fruits of your generosity. Some of the people you assist to go to school today will be a blessing to you in the future. Some of the children you help to keep alive and well in the orphanages will grow up to become men and women of great impact, bringing solutions to the problems of mankind, and heaven will never forget the contribution you made toward their development. The things you do for the poor today goes to wait for you in the future. Whatever you do for another man's child God will cause other people to do for your children and your

children's children. Whatever you make happen for others, God will make happen for you.

4. GOD WILL GIVE YOU MORE TO GIVE

There are two classes of people in the world today: the sowers and the eaters. Even in the body of Christ today, we have more people who are looking for promises to claim and how to receive 'more blessings' than people who are looking for more ways to be a blessing to other people. After a while, the gap between the sower and the eater becomes significantly wider. As you commit to being on the giving side, God ensures that you never lack what to give.

2 Corinthians 9:10 says,

"Now He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness."

God will keep providing and multiplying your resources so that you will have more to give. God

becomes your covenant partner when you give to the poor. That way you will never lack what to give.

5. YOUR GIVING BRINGS GLORY TO GOD

When the poor and the needy have their needs met, they give praise and glory to God. Imagine the honour of being responsible for sessions of praise and worship ascending to the throne of God from the homes of the people whose lives you have touched by your giving.

“You will be abundantly enriched in every way as you give generously on every occasion, for when we take your gifts to those in need, it causes many to give thanks to God. The priestly ministry you are providing through your offering not only supplies what is lacking for God’s people, it inspires an outpouring of praises and thanksgiving to God Himself.” 2 Corinthians 9:11-12 (TPT)

When praises ascend to heaven because of your generous giving to other people in need, God will keep on decorating you. You cannot be responsible for bringing glory to the name of the Lord and still suffer shame. It is not possible. God will destroy everything bringing shame and reproach to your life and your family. I am sure I will receive a testimony from one reader of this book to confirm this, in Jesus' name.



START NOW

God does not reward intentions, but He blesses the doers of His word. You have learned a lot so far about giving to the poor and the blessings that accompany it. It is time for you to put what you have learnt to work. Like I said earlier, do not say “When I become wealthy, I will start giving to the poor.” Begin from where you are now. Prove to God that He can trust you with money. If you are faithful with the little God has given you today, then God can commit more to your trust.

“He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust in much.” - Luke 16:10

Start from where you are today, begin with what you have and God will multiply it. Catch a dream of being a blessing to the entire world. See yourself feeding thousands of families. See yourself giving scholarships to thousands of children. See yourself sponsoring orphanages and foster homes. See yourself building schools in rural villages. See yourself providing clean water for communities. See yourself building houses for old people. See yourself taking care of missionaries and their families. See yourself building and renovating schools and churches. See yourself singlehandedly building and renovating hospitals for communities. See your trucks taking groceries to communities. Now let's take it a step higher. See yourself asking Governors "How would you want me to help develop your State?" See yourself funding research and the manufacturing of

medications to fight diseases in many nations. If you can imagine it and believe it, God can enable you to accomplish it.

It is great to dream big, but you must begin small. It is great to dream about a future of global impact, but you must get busy in the present making a local impact. If you want to feed thousands of homes in the future, you can begin by buying a family 2kg of rice today. If you dream of funding a foster home tomorrow, you should begin by buying diapers for a child today. If you dream of building schools tomorrow, you should begin by buying a child a set of school uniforms today. If you dream of building churches tomorrow, you should begin by buying electricity for a local church in a poor neighborhood. You have something to start with right now. The truth is that anything you do for the needy, whether big or small touches the heart of God. Why not begin today? By the time you are done with this chapter, find something to give and get the

process started. Do not put it off. Procrastination is an enemy of faith.

From today, put something aside from all your income, no matter how small, to give to the needy. Be intentional, committed, and consistent about it as you are with your tithes and offerings. Whenever you go shopping for the month, include some things to give to the poor and needy. Again, I assure you by the leading of the Holy Ghost that if you continue faithfully and consistently with this for three months, you will experience supernatural increases in your finances, in Jesus' name. I am so convinced that many people will share their testimonies with me very soon. Please send me your testimonies. I want to rejoice with you.

I declare that you have stepped into your season of overflowing in Jesus' name. I release the anointing of increase on your finances right now. I command you to be fruitful, multiply, subdue the earth and have dominion, in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

PRAYER FOR SALVATION AND BAPTISM IN THE HOLY GHOST
